Week 3: July 2-6 (no camp on July 4th)

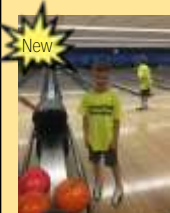

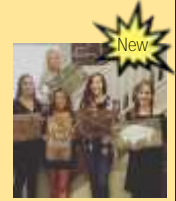

Week 6: July 23-27

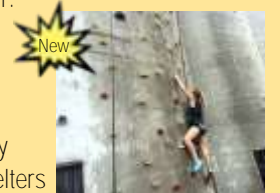
